Night Life
For those with energy to spare Utila offers a wide range of bars and restaurants, from night fish watching mojitos at Tranquila to swinging your feet of a tree bridge at Treetanic.

Freediving
With deep, clear waters just few hundred meters off-shore and a great school, Utila has become a freediving Mecca for Central America. World champion William Trubridge learned his skills on one of the Utila Cays.

The least developed of the three biggest Bay Islands, Utila has great diving, hiking, wonderful beaches, great food and a relaxed atmosphere. There are miles of deserted northern coast to explore and jungle and savanna forest that few people visit. Pumpkin hill, the highest hill of this mostly low-lying island is an extinct volcano. Utila was inhabited by Paya Indians until 1650 and their yaba-ding-dings and burial sites are scattered all over. A dozen Cayman Island families settled the Utila Cays and East Harbour beginning in 1831. After nine year stint as part of the British Crown Utila has returned to Honduras in 1859 its inhabitants led a quit, out of the Hurricane path life of fishing and fruit panting for the next century-and-a-half. Divers discovered Utila in 1980s and since the island had grown five fold. It is now home to 8,000 independent and resourceful islanders.

Chepes Beach
Chepes beach is a public beach located on the west end of Utila town. The white sand beach is a place to hang out, snorkel, or have a relaxing drink. You can look at all the activities in Utila bay, launch a kite, or watch sting rays.
